



	November End of year competition	Best Beginner	Images shall have been entered in the 1-star section during the year.
		2. Landscapes	Outdoors scenes, land, sea, urban and cityscapes. Changing elements of the scene is not allowed.
		3. Visual Art Photography	Achieving an artistic effect through application of creative techniques.
		4. Nature	Living, natural organisms (undomesticated) in their natural habitats. Plants and animals included. Excluded scenic/ landscapes/ cityscapes. No manipulation.
		5. Macro and Floral	Includes both macro and floral (flowers in their natural state or under controlled conditions and not to include any landscape)
		6. Photojournalism	Newsworthy, story-telling pictures including sport. Images may not be manipulated
November		7. Portraits	Includes both Animal and Human portraits. May be manipulated.
		8. Pictorial	Open category. It includes Architecture.
		9. Best of the Year	All category winners will compete automatically
		10. Monochrome	Monochrome as per PSSA Standard. This may not be the same as an image in any other category, except Most Versatile.
		11. Most Versatile	Entrants shall submit a panel of five (5) images each selected from five (5) different categories. These may include images entered for other awards.
		12. Most Golds and COM's	Per Stream (Winner of the Points Log accumulated through the year in terms of competition rules)

SET SUBJECTS 2022			
January	Looking up. An image of what you would see, as if looking up at it.		
February	Using a mirror(s) creatively. An image where the reflection in a mirror(s) is clearly visible. When looking at the image the word "mirror" must immediately come to mind!!		
March	Double exposure. A creative image where double exposure was used. A combination of more than one image must be prominent. It can either be achieved in-camera or in post processing.		
April	Minimalistic landscapes. A landscape scene with minimalism and simplicity as the main features.		
May	Water droplets. Water droplets must be the prominent feature of the image. Natural or in-studio.		
June	Panorama. An image with horizontally elongated fields of view. A field of view approximating or greater than that of the human eye.		
July	Serenity: simple, soft, shallow depth of field. Any image with very shallow depth of field and soft colours, creating a calming effect on the viewer.		
August	Textures. Textures must be the main feature of the image. When looking at the image you should be able to imagine how the image will feel like when you touch it!!		
September	Macro. A zoomed-in shot of any object, plant, insect, etc., or part of it.		
October	Clouds. An image where clouds are the main focal point.		
November	Year-end competition.

Acceptances after this date will be taken into account the next month.

NOTICE REGARDING SALON ACCEPTANCES

We have had a number of queries about missing Salon Acceptances in Photovault. This is how it works:

Once a LOCAL salon is complete AND the administrator releases the results, then the results become available for us to upload. We do this just before each meeting.

The release by administrators can take a while. International salons and special competitions are NOT available.

As has always been the case, the authoritative list of salon acceptances is with the competition secretary, Alta Oosthuizen, and all results must be sent to her.

From her records, we update only the NUMBER of acceptances from these other competitions from time to time, particularly as members approach promotion.

So please treat the results in PVO as only part of your success, sometimes with a lag in showing local salon results.



WHAT ARE PHOTOGRAPHY OVERLAYS?

Overlays are an image, an element or a texture that is added, by nature, on top of an existing image, most often done in Adobe Photoshop.

They allow digital photographers to drag and drop a "secret sauce" onto their images to produce effects that may otherwise have been impossible.



You no longer need to watch the forecast for that fluffy, white snow day, or wait for the "the golden hour" to create the perfect image. By adding the overlays, you can "build" your image to suit the desired effects you're looking for.

WHY USE OVERLAYS?

There's a <u>creative overlay</u> for every single look or feel that you desire to take your image to the next level, no matter what style or type of photography you're in.

In <u>post-production</u> of an image these overlays enhance the look and feel of the photo during post-production to add just about any desired effect including some of the most popular overlays which are smoke, water, or dust.

Use overlays to rescue a photo that isn't working how you want it to, or *take it from unusable to a successful image*.

HOW DO YOU MAKE PROFESSIONAL OVERLAYS?

Professional overlays are made by photographing real-life textures or elements such as smoke, snow, haze, carpet, the sun or concrete.

<u>Textural overlays</u> can be made by scanning an object like a baking sheet or piece of fabric. They can also be created from scratch in Photoshop.

HOW DO YOU APPLY AND USE OVERLAYS IN PHOTOSHOP?

Overlays are saved as standard .jpg files so that they can be uploaded on top of an image that you want to enhance.

Here are basic instructions on how to install an overlay:

- 1. Open the file of an image you want to enhance in Photoshop
- 2. Drag your overlay file directly onto the image
- 3. Change the Blend Mode of the overlay layer from "normal" to "screen". This will allow you to see your image with the overlay on it.
- 4. Transform, rotate, or move the overlay to your liking and then press enter/return to place the overlay.
- 5. Experiment with colour, contrast, and other adjustments to the overlay. Then experiment with using multiple overlays on more of your own images!

WHERE CAN I FIND OVERLAYS?

Are you just getting started with Overlays? You don't need to create your own elements or textures to start using overlays. Try a simple Google search and you'll learn that they are everywhere.

The most popular types of Overlays include: sky, stars, cloud, bubbles, leaves, flare, haze, bubbles sunlight, bokeh, confetti, rain, smoke, dust, glitter, fog, smoke, fire, sparks/sparkler.



However, the problem with most free overlays is that they are not designed for large, high-resolution images. You'll also want to check for copyright and usage permissions. Overlays that are not a decent size and high resolution will not show well for your clients.

In addition, some sites require you to backlink to them when using their examples, while other sites allow you to use their overlays for personal but not commercial use (which means you can't sell your work – what fun is that?)

That said, we have some great news for you! No need to spend a ton of time searching for free overlays!

Start with these 3 FREE overlays from RGG EDU to practice with.

WHAT ARE SOME ADVANCED OVERLAY TECHNIQUES?

Organize Your Workflow: Once you find the overlays you're looking for, we suggest organizing them into folders. This way, you'll no longer search for or create overlays from scratch. Once organized, you may easily drag and drop from a folder. This will speed up your workflow and save time. Instructions on how to do this is included for our individual overlays.

Start Blending! Once you've got your feet wet and your comfortable using overlays this is when the real creative process begins! You'll soon discover yourself using several at a time in each image as your style develops!

Will one size fit all? Will I need more than one set of overlays, or will I need different packs from similar artists? This is hard to say, but there's so many to choose from now, it will be completely up to your taste!

That's it, now get to work! Stretch it, rotate it, choose transparency with opacity slider, use the eraser or create a layer mask to thin out or remove sections of the overlay, try a few layer blend modes, add the same texture multiple times with different hues.... and remember, have fun!
